ARIANA GRANDE ANNOUNCES DATE CHANGES FOR THE SWEETENER WORLD TOUR SURROUNDING COACHELLA HEADLINE DATES

**Las Vegas Date Added on May 11; Tickets On Sale to the General Public Starting
Friday, January 18**



LOS ANGELES, CA (January 14, 2019) — Due to her recently announced Coachella headline appearance, Ariana Grande revealed a handful of date changes today to her upcoming North American *The Sweetener World Tour*.

The North American run, initially scheduled to wrap June 26, will now wrap July 13 to accommodate rescheduled dates in Chicago, Columbus, Indianapolis, St. Louis, Milwaukee, St. Paul, Denver and Salt Lake City that were initially scheduled for April 2019. The Omaha and Raleigh dates of the tour have been cancelled with refunds available at point of purchase. Please see new rescheduled dates **bolded** in itinerary below.

The multiplatinum superstar also announced a Las Vegas date has been added to the tour on May 11 at T-Mobile Arena. American Express® Card Members can purchase tickets before the general public beginning Tuesday, January 15 at 10am local time through Thursday, January 17 at 10pm local time. Tickets for the Las Vegas date will go on sale to the general public beginning Friday, January 18 at 10am local time at Ticketmaster.com. All other previously announced shows are on sale now.

Produced by Live Nation, *The Sweetener World Tour* kicks off March 18 in Albany, NY and will make 50 stops across North America. Previously revealed special guests Normani and Social House will also perform on each stop.

2018 marked yet another historic year for **GRANDE**. She concluded a banner twelve months with the distinction of being named *Billboard's* "Woman of the Year" and received a pair of GRAMMY®

Award nominations in the categories of “Best Pop Vocal Album” for her latest album ***Sweetener*** and “Best

Pop Solo Performance” for “**God Is A Woman.**” Simultaneously, her recent single “**thank u, next**” bowed at #1 on the *Billboard* Hot 100 and smashed the record for “**Most Spotify Streams for a Song By A Female Artist in a Single Week.**”

ABOUT ARIANA GRANDE

With her powerful vocals and astonishing range, Ariana Grande has emerged as one of the most magnetic and massively successful performers in music today. At age 25, she's delivered three platinum-selling albums and surpassed 30 billion streams, in addition to nabbing six Grammy Award nominations, and landing 11 hits in the Top 10 on the *Billboard* Hot 100 chart.

In November, Grande released the title track for her upcoming fifth album "*thank u, next*," which racked up the most weekly streams ever for a song by a female artist while topping *Billboard's* Hot 100 chart for multiple weeks. The video holds the record for the biggest music video debut in YouTube history, earning 55.4 million views in its first 24 hours. It is also the fastest video to earn 100 million views, reaching that milestone just four days following its release. Thanks largely to the success of "*thank u, next*," Grande (*Billboard's* 2018 "Woman of the Year") was the Top Streamed female artist on Spotify in 2018.

Since making her full-length debut with 2013's *Yours Truly* (featuring the game-changing, triple-platinum smash "The Way"), Grande has brought her striking vocal presence to a genre-blurring breed of pop, taking on R&B, soul, and electronic music with equal nuance and assurance. Arriving in 2014, her sophomore effort, *My Everything*, featured the 6x-platinum hits "Problem" and "Bang Bang." In 2016, Grande released the critically acclaimed *Dangerous Woman*, which included the singles "Dangerous Woman," "Into You," and "Side to Side." In 2018, Grande's fourth album, *Sweetener*, debuted at #1 on the *Billboard* Top 200 Album chart and spawned the singles "God is a Woman," "breathin'," and lead single "No Tears Left To Cry." Grande is the first artist in music history to have the lead single from her first five albums debut on the Top 10 on the *Billboard* Hot 100.

Through the years, the longtime actress and former Broadway star has proven the scope of her talent by appearing on *Scream Queens* and *Hairspray Live!* and showcased her comedic chops by hosting *Saturday Night Live*. With her social media following now surging past 200 million, Grande has also earned numerous accolades from the MTV Video Music Awards, iHeartRadio Music Awards, and American Music Awards, including the highly coveted Artist of the Year prize.
